Bishop Bruce Caldwell and I invite ten youth ages 15 to 18 years of age to participate in a Wind & Wings (W&W) mission trip to Honduras where we will have the opportunity to encounter sounds, sights and smells of another unique culture. By volunteering to serve, you may risk experiencing a personal & spiritual life change of a wonderful and grace filled dimension. The W&W youth team will be serving a people who are quite remarkable and distinct from our culture in Wyoming. Our destination is the town of Siguatepeque in the central pine forested highlands of Honduras where about 18,000 people live and work near several attractive lakes. Siguatepeque is located about half the distance from San Pedro Sula and the capital city of Tegucigalpa. We invite dentists and dental hygienists, a physician and a nurse to volunteer to conduct dental & medical wellness clinics under the oversight of Elmer B. Mejia, M.D. our friend and diocesan representative in Honduras. Also needed are three adult co-mentors to assist with youth leadership training. The purpose of the trip is to create the opportunity for the youth of Wyoming to participate in a mission trip with co-mentors and provide opportunities for the youth to lead, serve, contribute and learn from this experience. This learning can be shared and developed for the benefit of her/his congregation and community through models of leadership and service. We'll spend the last two days of the trip at a beach hotel at Tela playing in the Caribbean surf before we fly back to the US. There will soon be an *application form, a release from liability form and a day to day trip itinerary posted on the diocesan web site and updated as we glean details.* If you want to participate in this servant ministry trip, act sooner than later as space is limited.
